1st International Conference – «Countering Staff Shortage Among Health Professions – Together for a Healthy Health Care System», on the 25th and 26th of October, 2018

On behalf of the Competence Network Health Workforce (CNHW) we invite health scientists, practitioners, researchers, managers and policymakers to attend the 1st international conference on workforce shortage in health care professions. It will take place in Bern, Switzerland, on the 25th and 26th of October, 2018.

The CNHW has organized this conference. It is formed by five Universities of Applied Sciences in Health in Switzerland (Bern University of Applied Sciences BFH, FHS St.Gallen University of Applied Sciences, HES-SO University of Applied Sciences and Arts Western Switzerland, University of Applied Sciences and Arts of Southern Switzerland SUPSI, Zurich University of Applied Sciences ZHAW) within the project «Strategy to counter staff shortage among health professions». The conference will take place every two years.

The staff shortage is one of the biggest challenges health care systems worldwide have to face. Without adequate human resources there is no patient safety and no health in healthcare! Therefore knowledge and networking to counter this shortage in the health care system is urgently needed.

This first conference will focus on clinically relevant, praxisorientated and interprofessional scientific knowledge, regarding measures aimed at reducing workforce shortage among health professions. The conference theme, «Countering Staff Shortage Among Health Professions – Together for a Healthy Health Care System», aims to encourage clinicians, educators and researchers to participate as visitors and/or as presenters. It also aims to offer a first comprehensive overview of the work completed to date within this topic. As a Competence Network Health Workforce, it is in our interest to provide the opportunity to network and to establish contacts. Beside the geographical diversity of presenters, along with the diverse conference program, provides a framework offering for multiple perspectives and opportunities.

We would be pleased if you could also submit your contribution to the topic. Your input would serve as an example in changing the triggers and outcomes regarding workforce shortage among the health professions of tomorrow.

- 3. Poster presentation: lead, 3-5 minutes
